North Takes Series With Opening and Closing Wins; South and North Play to 3-3 tie in Game Two

Corvallis, Oregon, June 20, 2016 – The North beat the South 10-3 in game one of the 2016 Reser's All-Star Series on Saturday, June 18. Westview's Kenyon Yovan tossed five shutout innings to earn the win. The Oregon commit struck out 7 while allowing only one hit and a walk. Patrick Harvey of Hood River powered the North offense going 3-for-3 with two doubles.

The Oregon All-Star Series wrapped up with the North taking the series by blanking the South 3-0 on one hit in the finale. Bryce Mulcahy of St. Helen's tossed 4 innings of scoreless and hitless baseball to earn the win for the North. Brandon Eister of Aloha registered the save as the left-hander tossed a scoreless final inning while recording two strikeouts. Sunday's first game ended in a 3-3 tie after 7 innings.

Future OSU commit – Sherwood's Adley Rutschman of the North - earned Bob Brockman MVP honors. Yovan and McMinnville's Kade Mechals were named North and South Most Outstanding Pitchers, respectively. Harvey earned North Most Outstanding Player honors and Noah Yunker of Summit was the South MOP.
