Oregon All-Series Announces Rosters

Monday, June 4, Corvallis, Ore – The Freightliner Oregon All-Star Series, which features the state's top senior 6A and 5A high school baseball players, unveiled their North and South rosters this morning, as announced by 6A coordinator Jake Anders and 5A coordinator Dave Williams. The three-game showcase series is set for June 23-24 at Oregon State University's Goss Stadium at Coleman Field.

The North roster includes three seniors from this year's 6A state champion, Westview. The Wildcats are the most represented program in the Oregon All-Star Series.

The South roster features University of Oregon commit Aaron Zavala of South Salem as well as University of Utah commit Briley Knight of Crescent Valley and University of Portland commit Cole Wilkinson of Churchill.

The Oregon High School Baseball All-Star Series showcases the top senior players from the state's 5A and 6A classifications over a set of games held each third or fourth weekend in June. The All-Star Series thrived in The Dalles for decades (1971-2007) as the State-Metro Series and celebrated its 50th anniversary in its last year at Quinton Street Ball Park in The Dalles. Bend hosted the 5A Series in 2008 and 2009 while the 6A Series was held in McMinnville those same years before the two classifications combined to play a 5A/6A All-Star Series last year in McMinnville. The Oregon High School Baseball Coaches Association moved the series to Corvallis in 2011. Reser's Fine Foods was the title sponsor from 2011-2016.
